

Chirp Chirp™ - Let's Play the Game

The instructions for playing Chirp Chirp™ are very easy to follow. What makes this game fun is the searching as well as seeing who can spot the most target vehicles. This is a free game and everyone is welcome to print this More and more people are "Chirping" across our nation so why not you!

The object of the game is to spot all the yellow vehicles you encounter. They can be cars, trucks, construction vehicles for transportation*, school busses (even though some may be more orange than yellow) or any other form of yellow transportation. When you see a yellow vehicle, you simply say Chirp Chirp™ and mark your point down. Keeping score you will see who has the keen Chirp Chirp™ eye! If two people spot and chirp the same vehicle at the same time a tie is called and both people can mark the point. All vehicles chirped must be seen by all playing members. Only one chirp per vehicle is allowed (unless a tie is called). When someone new enters the car and wishes to play, a new game starts.

Buttons, bumper stickers, window decals and T shirts are common in some areas and some people have made a game out of playing this game while walking down the street. They see a Chirp Chirp™ product and they chirp it in addition to the vehicles they spot. You may not see too many in your area but sometime soon, I'm sure you will so keep your Chirp Chirp™ eyes watching.

Safety Rules to Follow!

- 1) Everyone playing the game MUST have their seat belt on!
- 2) If the driver is talking on the cell phone and it is not a "hands free" one, the game is suspended until the driver hangs up!
- 3) Eating that meal on the go is popular today but very distracting. We at Chirp Chirp™ suggest you do not eat and drive, however if you do, the game is to be suspended.
- 4) No yelling or arguing while the game is in progress. Have fun with the game but please do not fight over who saw what yellow vehicle first.
- 5) We at Chirp Chirp™ do not encourage the driver to play. Their job is safe driving. Playing the game can distract them from road conditions. Therefore, Chirp Chirp™ must say, "drivers, do not play Chirp Chirp™ and drive"!
- 6) Road conditions can sometime distract the driver. It can be weather, heavy traffic or an oncoming accident. When road conditions turn bad, the game is suspended at once!
- 7) NO SPEEDING ALLOWED!

Foot Notes

- * Construction equipment such as fork lifts, earth movers or any other form that is not used strictly for transportation can not be chirped.
- * Again, drivers are to avoid playing the game. We at Chirp Chirp™ say;
- *** Don't play Chirp Chirp™ and drive,
- *** Don't eat and drive and
- *** **Don't drink and drive!**
